The Centre is proud to offer the Research Techniques for Public Service Short Learning Programme (SLP), designed to strengthen the analytical and reporting capabilities of public sector officials. The programme responds to common challenges in public institutions, including weak data credibility, poor indicator design, limited analytical interpretation, and reporting practices that fail to support informed decision-making.

COURSE OBJECTIVE

To equip public sector officials with practical research, analytical, and reporting skills that enable them to collect, verify, analyse, interpret, and communicate evidence effectively for planning, accountability, performance improvement, and service delivery.

TARGET PARTICIPANTS

This programme is suitable for:

- Team leaders and supervisors in national, provincial, and local government
- Officials responsible for data collection, analysis, and reporting
- Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E) practitioners
- Administrative and operational staff involved in performance reporting.
- Assistant Directors and junior managers responsible for report compilation and verification

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum Matric qualification
- Two to five years of exposure to reporting, administration, monitoring, evaluation, or related public sector functions

COURSE CONTENT

The course is structured into six integrated modules delivered over three days:

- **DAY 1:** Foundations of Public Sector Research, Data Credibility & Research Ethics
- **DAY 2:** Analytical Thinking, Indicator Design & Evidence Interpretation
- **DAY 3:** Analytical Report Writing & Evidence-to-Action Translation

Each module builds progressively from data collection and validation to analysis, interpretation, and reporting.

KEY LEARNING OUTCOMES

Upon completion, participants will be able to:

- 1 Identify and define relevant research problems within the public sector context.
- 2 Apply appropriate methods to collect, manage, and evaluate the credibility of data.
- 3 Design clear, measurable, and relevant performance indicators.
- 4 Analyse and interpret data to generate meaningful insights.
- 5 Produce structured, clear, and analytical reports that translate evidence into action.
